the children need to go to school.

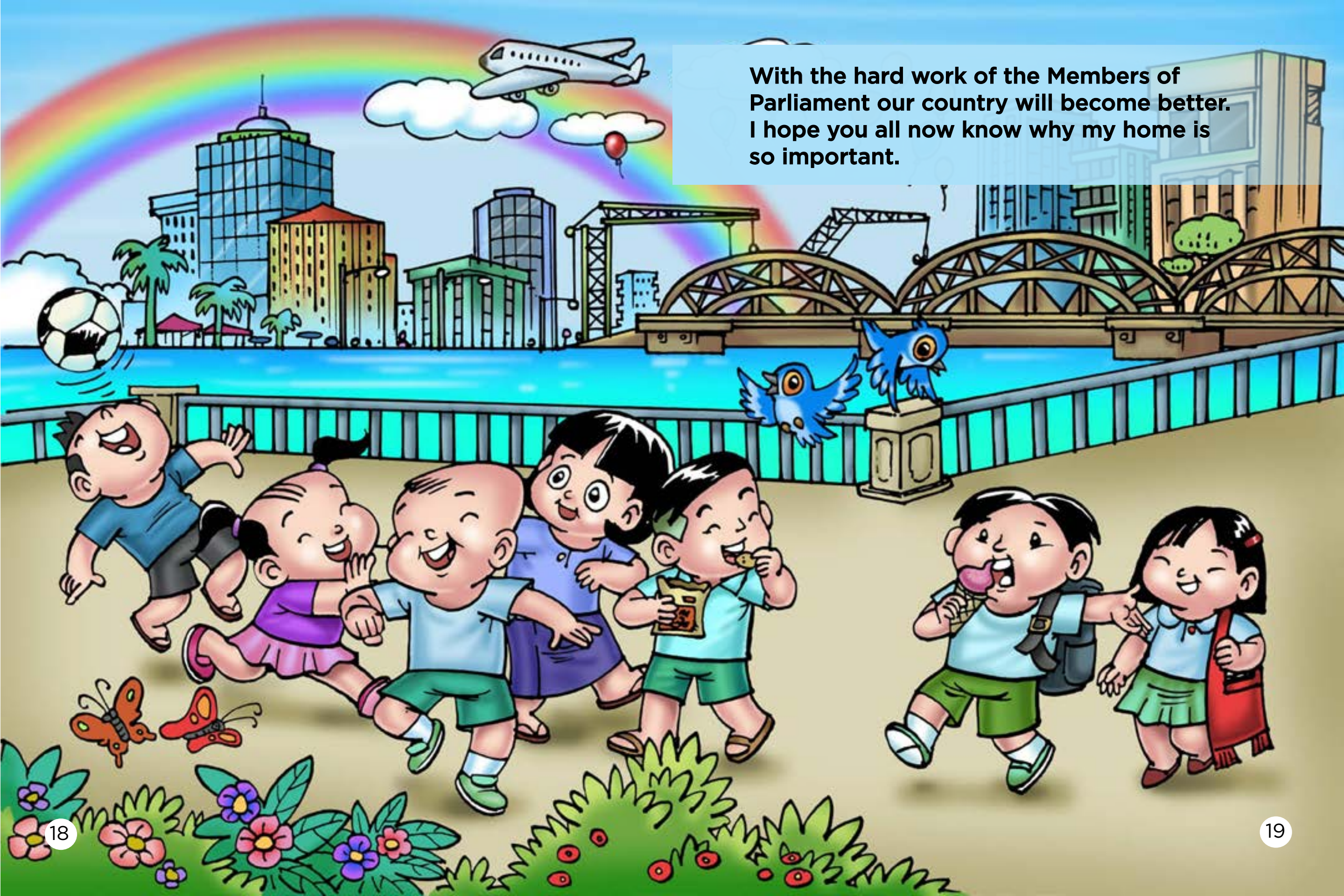


They do better things after discussing with people in the community.
